








We like play structures that incorporate natural elements and tie into the landscape


There is a real lack of farmers markets in SB and I'm really excited about having one in the park

The tennis courts are well-loved now- can we add more for the future Moakley Park? I'd like to see concessions with clean bathrooms


I hope they put in a water feature, preferably a pool. Like surrounding towns have and if not a pool, and actual working splash pad

Please build a skate park on Day Blvd side near the police station! Accessible by T. Noise not an issue!


New lighting would allow us to play for longer; right now have to rely on the sun How can we have pollinators throughout the park?






