


HOW TO GET RID OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE IN BOSTON:

ZERO WASTE DAY

- Accepts: batteries, electronics, chemicals, oil-based paint, lightbulbs, car related materials, textiles, and paper for shredding
