## COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE

The Boston City Council's Committee on Ways and Means will hold a hearing on **Monday, February 9, 2026 at 2:00 pm**. This hearing will be held **virtually**.

The subjects of the hearing are:

*Docket #0128, Message and order for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to appropriate the amount of Six Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,500,000.00) for the purpose of paying costs for the window and door replacement projects at the following schools: the Edward Everett Elementary School and the Richard J. Murphy K-8 School. This includes the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto, and for which the City of Boston may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the Public Facilities Department on behalf of the Boston Public Schools.*

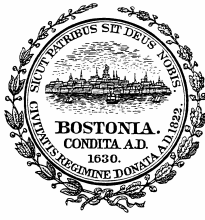
*Docket #0129, Message and order for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to appropriate the amount of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) for the purpose of paying costs for the roof replacement projects at the following schools: the Thomas J. Kenny Elementary School and Hugh Roe O'Donnell Elementary School. This includes the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto, and for which the City of Boston may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority ("MSBA"), said amount to be expended under the direction of the Public Facilities Department on behalf of the Boston Public Schools.*

These matters were sponsored by Mayor Michelle Wu and were referred to the Committee of the Whole on January 28, 2026; they were referred to the Committee on Ways and Means on February 4, 2026.
