MOH is hosting meetings and taking comments from residents and other interested parties on a draft budget and spending plan for an estimated \$27 million in funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the program year 7/1/26-6/30/27. The funds may be invested in housing, homeless assistance and community development programs that serve low to moderate income residents. The Plan covers four federal programs: *Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)*, *HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME)*, *Emergency Solutions Grant Program (ESG)* + *Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA)*
