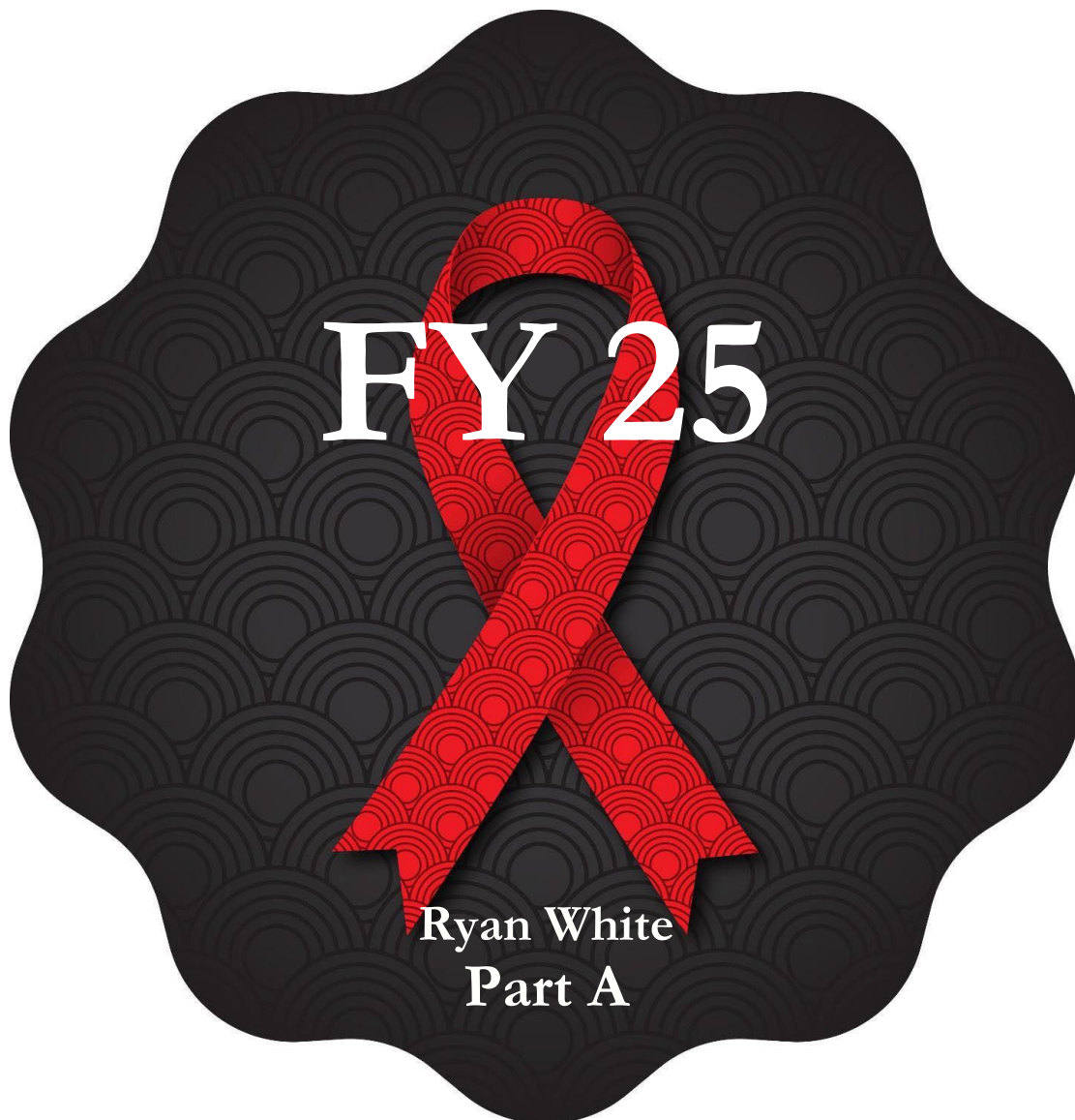




# Ryan White Services Resource Guide



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## Introduction

This guide provides information on Part A-funded HIV service providers in the Boston Eligible Metropolitan Area (Boston EMA). The Boston EMA covers 7 counties in MA; Bristol, Essex, Middlesex, Norfolk, Plymouth, Suffolk, and Worcester, and 3 counties in New Hampshire – Hillsborough, Rockingham, and Strafford.

Agencies who provide MAI services make sure that the service is culturally and linguistically appropriate to reduce barriers and increase access to care for minorities who are living with HIV/AIDS. The agencies that are funded under MAI are denoted by an asterisk \*.
