Final cost may vary based on size, variety and availability. The client or person responsible for the work must be on site the day of the project to approve the planting location(s) and plant placement. **4,865.00**  
\*\* Price also includes permits and three seasonal soil applications of a liquid organic soil biostimulant designed to support healthy soils and root system development.

\*\* Client must obtain written consent from the Back Bay Architectural Commission (BBAC) prior to installation.

Please maintain markings placed by member utilities until the project has been completed. Client is responsible to mark underground irrigation, landscape lighting or any other non-utility services.

**Tree and Shrub Care Recommendations on 3/6/2026**

Description of Services

**- 31" diameter declining Chestnut tree in the front lawn:** 9,550.00

**Tree Removal & Stump Grinding** - Take down, dispose of brush, logs and chipped debris generated from removal operations. Grind stump and exposed flare 4-6" below grade; backfill and remove excess grinding debris. Note: machine will grind up to 4-6" from adjacent immobile objects; some stump portions may remain. We will not remove other inorganic debris, nor are we responsible for damage to unmarked irrigation and underground non-utility services.

\*\* Client must obtain written consent from the Back Bay Architectural Commission (BBAC) prior to removal.

\*\* Cost includes permits, police detail, labor and disposal.

Objective findings: Client requested tree be assessed for health and safety. On 3/6/26 a limited visual assessment was performed. Tree has visible trunk decay and corresponding branch dieback throughout canopy. Tree presents with no apparent trunk flare. Tree leans towards Beacon St., and may pose a risk to public safety. Based on limited visual assessment, removal and replacement with a BBAC approved ornamental tree is recommended.

- **Digsafe:** We will contact Digsafe to locate and mark underground utilities service lines on the property prior to performing digging &/or grinding operations. Please maintain markings placed by member utilities until the project has been completed. Client is responsible to mark underground irrigation, landscape lighting or any other non-utility services.
