## **CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING**

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove four (4) public shade trees at **154 Terrace Street, Mission Hill**.

The removal request is in order to provide an ADA-compliant sidewalk in front of the proposed 6 story building consisting of 65 rental units. The following trees are being requested for removal:

- One (1) Honeylocust tree measuring 5 inches DBH (diameter at breast height)
- Three (3) Honeylocust trees measuring 4 inches DBH.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) remotely on **Thursday, May 7, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. Via ZOOM.**
