

It is an election year at the Boston Retirement System. There are two Retirement Board seats that must be decided by way of election. Those eligible to cast votes include: active members, inactive members and retired members (not beneficiaries).

Please note that ballots will be mailed to your address of record. If you have moved and did not alert us, kindly contact the Board for a change of address form as soon as possible. You will have the option of mailing in a ballot or you may vote electronically.

- **Nomination papers:** Will be available in-person at Boston City Hall, Room 816, on June 30, 2026. The nomination paper must be returned with at least 20 eligible voters (active members, inactive members, and retired members) no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 17, 2026, at the office of the Boston Retirement Board.
- **Eligible candidate:** Any active member or retiree of the Boston Retirement System who successfully files nomination papers.
- **Requirements for nomination papers:** Any active member or retired member of the Boston Retirement System may qualify as a candidate by filing with the Election Officer of the Boston Retirement System a nomination paper, or papers, containing the signatures and addresses of at least twenty (20) members or retirees of the Boston Retirement System.
- **Deadline for nomination papers:** Filed at Boston City Hall, Room 816, no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 17, 2026.
- **Voting method:** Voter's option of either paper or electronic.
- **Election start:** August 21, 2026.
- **Election close:** September 25, 2026.
- **Term:** October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2029.
