



BOSTON SAVES LEARNING PATHWAYS

Helping students *learn, dream, and plan for their future.*

Boston Saves offers incentives that help students explore learning, careers, and financial skills. When students complete activities, they can earn money deposited directly into their Boston Saves account to help pay for college or career training after high school.

LEARN: EXPLORE BOOKS INCENTIVE FOR K2 – 3RD GRADE STUDENTS

Reading together helps children build strong literacy skills and a love of learning.

HOW IT WORKS

Read or explore books with your child for:

- 20 minutes a day
- 20 days in a month
- During a 3-month period

Eligible reading periods:

- October–December
- January–March
- April–June
- July–September

Families can read together, look at picture books, or talk about stories.

WHAT STUDENTS EARN

Students earn \$5 per quarter, up to \$20 per year. The money will be deposited into the student's Boston Saves account.

HOW TO CLAIM THE INCENTIVE

1. Log in to the Boston Saves Savings Center.
2. Submit the **Explore Books** form.
3. Incentives are deposited within a few weeks.

WHY THIS MATTERS

Reading regularly helps children:

- Build vocabulary.
- Strengthen comprehension.
- Succeed in school.
