Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Carvalho reported that OPAT had a full calendar of meetings during the first six weeks of the quarter, including Civilian Review Board (CRB) meetings and an OPAT Commission meeting held in advance of an IAOP session.

Director Carvalho reported that at the January 29th Commission meeting, the Commission voted to subpoena officers for upcoming CRB proceedings. Several officers appeared, including Larry Calderone- Chairman and President of the Patrolmen's Union, which Director Carvalho noted was helpful to the Board's work. For cases where officers were unable to attend, matters were postponed to allow officer participation.

Director Carvalho then invited the panel to observe a moment of silence in recognition of Jesse Jackson, sharing remarks emphasizing leadership, courage, initiative, and the responsibility of leaders to drive change.

Chair Fugate asked whether there were questions from the panel.

The panel asked whether there are consequences when individuals do not appear after being subpoenaed.

Director Carvalho stated that additional guidance and information on this matter would be forthcoming.
