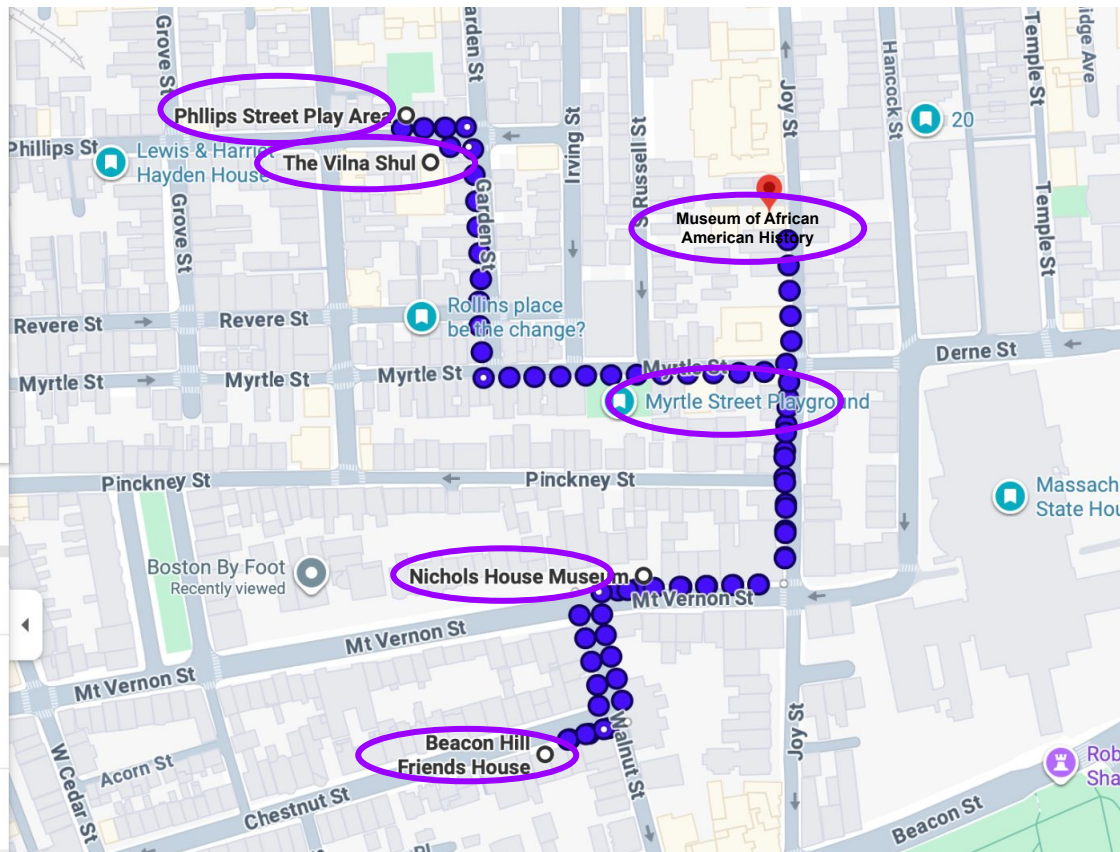

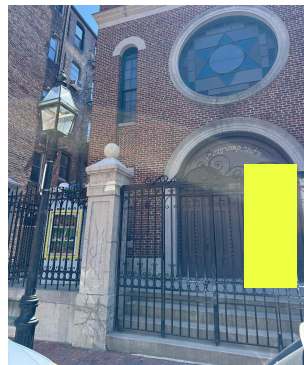

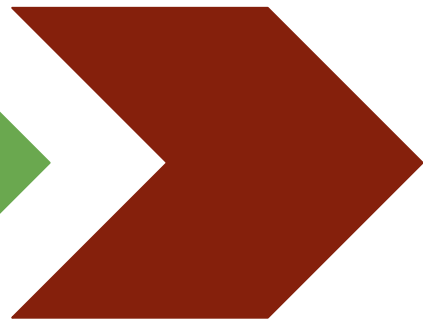
Be the Change 2027 | TIMELINE

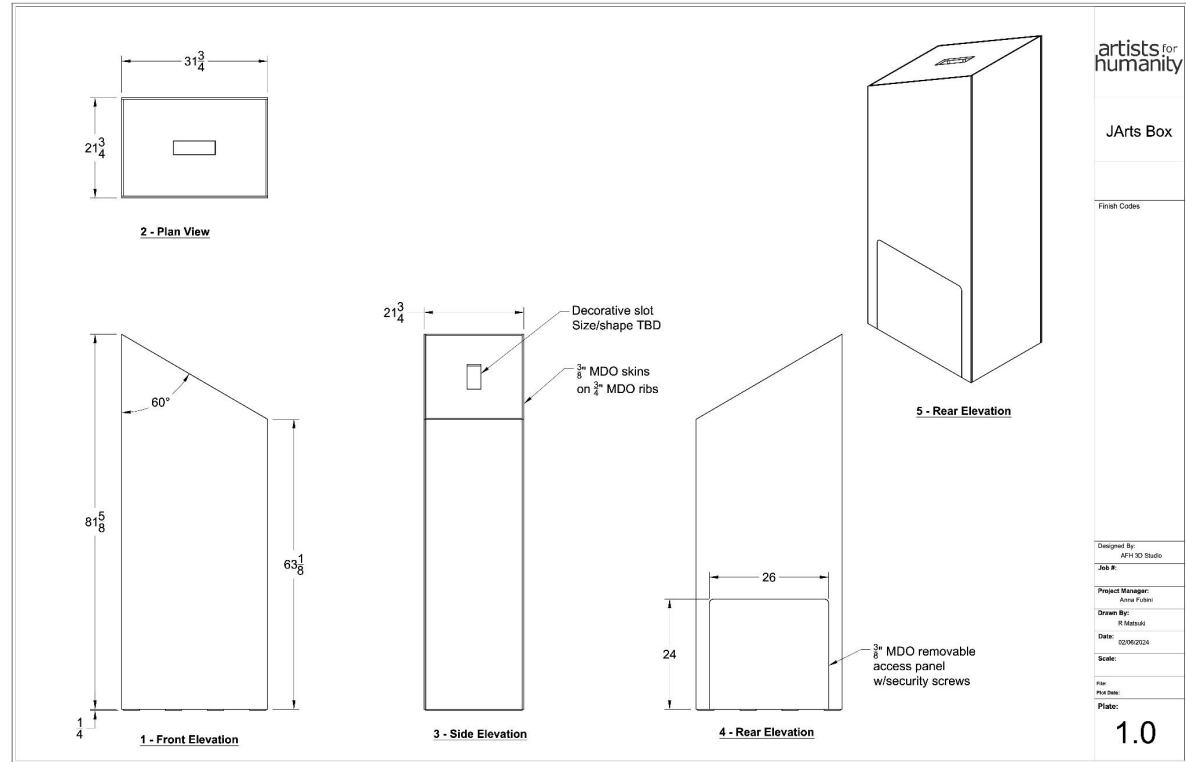

Be the Change 2027 | FABRICATION

- The base box sculptures are made of outdoor grade plywood.
- Each artist is charged with enhancing their box with materials that are safely adhered, or intended for audience engagement.
- Each box weighs 300-500 pounds and contain bags of sand to act as weights.



Be the Change 2027 | SIGNAGE & WAYFINDING

Corrugated plastic lawn signs and sandwich boards will be used to direct viewers.



Corrugated plastic lawn signs will mark the path on each block leading between the sculptures.



Sandwich boards will be placed outside of each sculpture while exhibit staff are on site.

Be the Change 2027 | MAINTENANCE PLAN

Staff at each site will be responsible for daily maintenance and oversight of the exhibit. Vilna and MAAH staff will maintain installations in the parks.

We have never had a significant maintenance or vandalism incident in the 5 years of this show.
