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Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Evandro Carvalho presented the Director's Report. He noted that this was the fourth and final meeting of the fiscal year and that the IAOP had achieved quorum at every meeting during the year.

Director Carvalho acknowledged his two-year anniversary with OPAT and also acknowledged recent officer-involved shooting incidents.

He reported that OPAT's public biweekly coffee hours continue to take place and the Open Door Days continue to be held on the first Wednesday of each month.

A board member inquired about a meeting between Director Carvalho and the City's General Counsel. Director Carvalho stated that he would continue participating in those discussions to strengthen collaboration and improve operations. He emphasized the hard work being performed by both the community and the internal OPAT team and stated that those efforts should remain the focus.
