The Boston City Council's Committee on Public Safety and Criminal Justice will hold a hearing on **Thursday, September 10, 2026 at 10:00 am** in the **Iannella Chamber, 5th Floor, Boston City Hall**.

The subjects of the hearing are:

Docket #0185, Order for a hearing on a cross-sector collaborative citywide strategy for community safety and violence prevention.
