CITY OF BOSTON TREE REMOVAL HEARING

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on the request to remove one (1) public shade tree at **112 Queensberry St, Fenway**.

This removal request is in order to facilitate the utility and drainage improvements, sidewalk and curb, and new residential driveway needed for the proposed 6 story new construction which consists of 24 units of affordable housing. It will require the removal and replacement of the following Public Shade Tree:

- One (1) Elm tree measuring 8 inches DBH (diameter at breast height).

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee) remotely on **Thursday, October 1, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. Via ZOOM.**
