(the "Institution," which term includes for purposes of this Notice any parent, subsidiary or other affiliate thereof) with respect to certain facilities owned or to be owned and operated by the Institution (including without limitation such financing, refinancing or reimbursement of bond reserves, capitalized interest and issuance costs), generally consisting of the financing of, and/or the refinancing of the acquisition of a 1.79 acre tract of land, along with a 37,400 square foot building on said tract, located at 174 Forest Hills Street, Jamaica Plain, Massachusetts 02130 and containing a 120-bed skilled nursing facility known as Laurel Ridge Rehabilitation and Skilled Care Center, and owned and operated, or to be owned and operated, by the Borrower (collectively, the "Project").

The Bonds will not constitute a general obligation of, or a pledge of the faith and credit of MassDevelopment or a general obligation of, or a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of the Commonwealth.
