FROM HER BY THE WAY CONNED HAND WORLDWIDE WELCOME. THE AIR BRIDGED HARBOR, THAT TWIN CITIES FRAME, KEEP AIN YENT LANDS YOUR STORIED POMP CRIES SHE WITH SILENT LIPS. THE IMPETUS FOR THIS WAS THE SITUATION THAT WAS WIDELY REPORTED WITH THE KIRK SISTERS AT A CHARTER SCHOOL IN THE REGION WHO WERE DISCIPLINED FOR WEARING THEIR HAIR IN A SIMILAR STYLE TO MY OWN. WE KNOW THAT SCHOOL DISCIPLINE POLICIES AS WELL AS CSHT CONTRIBUTE CONSIDERABLY. NEUTRAL ON THEIR FACE HAVE A DISPARATE IMPACT ON FIRLS OF COLOR. IN ON GIRLS OF COLOR. WE HEARD FROM THE NATIONAL JUSTICE INSTITUTE, DISCIPLINE AND OTHER POLICIES AS WELL AS WHAT THE GIRLS SHARED WITH FOCUS GROUPS WE CONDUCTED THIS SUMMER. WE'VE NEVER HAD TWO CATEGORY 4 HURRICANES IN A YEAR, WE HAD TWO IN ESSENTIALLY A WEEK AND A HALF. THE TIME TO ACT IS NOW AND WE GET INTO A LITTLE BIT MORE SPECIFICS BUT SUFFICE IT TO SAY I'M INTRODUCING A HEARING ORDER TO EVALUATE THE CITY'S RESPONSIVENESS TO EXTREME WEATHER EVENT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, WILL ADDRESS THE CURRENT EVACUATION PLAN AND PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE CASE OF A NATURAL WEATHER CATASTROPHE IN OUR CITY IDENTIFY A POTENTIAL REDUCTION IN FUNDING ASSISTANCE THAT MAY BE CURTAILED IN THE NATIONAL BUDGET. IT WILL ENSURE THE PROTECTION AND SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR IMPACTS OF GLOBAL CLIMATE CHANGE. WE ARE WITNESSING THE DEVASTATING EFFECTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE. I'M HAPPY TO ADDRESS THIS ANYWHERE ANY TIME. BUT PAN MADE CLIMATE CHANGE HAS A DIRECT EFFECT ON THIS INCREASE IN MAJOR WEATHER EVENTS. WE'VE BEEN VERY, VERY LUCKY DESPITE THE FACT THAT WE ARE INCREDIBLY SUSCEPTIBLE TO THE IMPACT OF CLIMATE CHANGE. IT IS IMPERATIVE AS A CITY WITH RISING SEA LEVELS WE'RE READY FOR CHANGING WEATHERS, SEA LEVELS ROSE MORE THAN 9 INCHES RELATIVE TO LAND. HOWEVER BY 2030 ANOTHER EIGHT

INCHES WILL RISE SO WE'RE TALKING ABOUT 100 YEARS GOING NINE INCHES AND THEN 30 YEARS GOING EIGHT. BY 2050, SEA LEVELS MAY RISE ONE AND A HALF FEET HIGHER THAN 2000. MAY BE AS MUCH AS THREE FEET HIGHER THAN THEY WERE JUST 17 YEARS AGO. WE MUST TAKE A COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH IN PROTECTING BOSTON RESIDENTS FROM BEING DETRIMENTALLY AFFECTED, SUCH AS HURRICANES IRMA, HARVEY, SANDY AND CREERNT. WE MUST IMPLEMENT A NUMBER OF INITIATIVES WE HAVE BEEN TALKING ABOUT ON THIS BODY FOR MANY, MANY MONTHS. THERE IS A LACK OF LEADERSHIP AND OUTRIGHT HOSTILITY IN WASHINGTON HINDERING EFFORTS TO AFFECT CLIMATE CHANGE. IN FACT THIS CURRENT FEDERAL ADMINISTRATION, THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION HAS CUT \$660 MILLION FROM FEMA'S BUDGET. IT'S UNCONSCIONABLE WHAT IS HAPPENING DOWN THERE AND NOW MORE THAN EVER IT IS UP TO CITIES AND TOWNS TO LEAD, I FEEL LIKE A BROKEN RECORD, THAT BECOMES MORE AND MORE TRUE UNFORTUNATELY WITH EVERY WEEK THAT PASSES. THE PURPOSE OF THIS HEARING IS NOT TO HAVE AN INDICTMENT, ON THE MAYORAL ADMINISTRATION OR PRIOR MAYORAL ADMINISTRATION. WE THINK IT IS A TREMENDOUS POSTING A BIANNUAL OR ANNUAL MEETING, CHECKING IN WITH DEPARTMENTS, WHAT ARE OUR PLANS? I'M THOUGHT QUITE SURE WHERE THEY GO ONE SENDS ME TO DEDHAM ONE SENDS ME TO BROOKLINE. BEST IN THE WORLD IN THIS CITY WE NEED TO MAKE SURE THAT THEY HAVE THE RESOURCES WE NEED. WE HAVE TO MAKE SURE WE'RE ALL ON THE SAME PAGE GOING FORWARD. AGAIN I'M NOT LOOKING TO POLITICIZE WHAT WE'RE DOING IN

BOSTON AS IT RELATES TO PREPAREDNESS. HOWEVER I DO THINK THIS BODY OUGHT TO LEAD ON THIS. MAKE SURE WE HAVE CHECK-INS PERIODICALLY TO MAKE SURE WE'RE PREPARED. UNFORTUNATELY, UNTIL THIS COUNTRY GETS ITS ACT TOGETHER RELATIVE TO CLIMATES CHANGE WE WILL SEE MORE HURRICANE IRMAS AND CHEAFER AND KATRINAS AND SANDIES AND SO FORTH. >> PLEASE ADD COUNCILOR PRESSLEY, COUNCILOR LINEHAN, COUNCILOR ESSAIBI-GEORGE, COUNCILLOR CIOMMO, ADD THE CHAIR AND COUNCILOR JACKSON YOU HAVE THE CHAIR. >> THANK YOU VERY MUCH. I WANT TO APPLAUD COUNCILOR O'MALLEY'S CONSISTENT EFFORT IN SHOWING THAT OUR CITY IS HERE. AND IN GOOD WORKING CONDITION IN THE FUTURE AND HIS ADVOCACY FOR ENVIRONMENT. I WOULD ALSO ADD, WE ALSO KNOW THAT EACH ONE OF THESE DISASTERS, THERE IS DATA THAT SAYS IT ACTUALLY INCHES UP POVERTY BY 1% NATIONALLY BY EACH ONE OF THESE DISASTERS. AND DISPROPORTIONATELY THOSE WHO ARE POOR ARE HURT. ONE OF THE THINGS THAT I WOULD ASK COUNCILOR O'MALLEY TO LOOK AT THAT WE ARE NOT EFFECTIVELY LOOKING AT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, WE JUST APPROVED FOLKS TO BE ON THE ZONING BOARD. WE KNOW THERE IS 36 INCHES OF WATER THAT IS GOING TO BE CLOSE TO THE SEA PORT AREA. WHEN YOU STAND AT THE CONVENTION CENTER, YOU ARE WAY HIGHER THAN YOU ARE WHEN YOU ARE IN THE SEA PORT DISTRICT. WE KNOW THAT THAT AREA IS GOING TO BE FLOODED. IF WE DO NOTHING. WE ALSO KNOW IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, YOU CAN'T BUILD A BUILDING THAT IS NOT RESISTANT TO EARTHQUAKES.

AND SO IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, WE NEED TO REEVALUATE OUR ZONING CODE. AND I KNOW WE HAVE A HUGE BOOM THAT'S OCCURRING RIGHT NOW. BUT IF WE KNOW THE WATER IS COMING, WHY IS THAT IT WE ARE DOING NOTHING TO UPGRADE THE ZONING CODE TO ENSURE THAT THE BUILDINGS HAVE THE INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDED TO ENSURE THAT THREE WILL BE THERE IN PERPETUITY? THE OTHER COMPONENT IS WE KNOW THAT THIS IS PART OF OUR TAX BASE AND SO TO HAVE US STABILIZE THE TAX BASE WE NEED TO MAKE SURE THOSE BUILDINGS ARE PROTECTED.I WOULD ENCOURAGE IN THIS HEARING HOW WE ARE ABLE TO UPDATE AND UPGRADE OUR ZONING CODE SO IT'S RELEVANT FOR 2017 AND INTO THE FUTURE. YES WE NEED PREPAREDNESS BUT OUR BODY NEEDS TO LOOK AT THE RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT WILL ACTUALLY GUIDE US INTO THE FUTURE SO WE ARE PREPARED. PLEASE ADD MY NAME AND AGAIN KUDOS FOR YOUR STEADFAST EFFORT IN THIS SPACE. >> THANK YOU COUNCILOR JACKSON. DOCKET NUMBER 1197 WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY. >> DOCKET NUMBER 1198 COUNCILORS PRESSLEY AND CAMPBELL OFFERED THE FOLLOWING: RESOLUTION URGING THE LEGISLATURE TO PASS H.742 AN ACT AMENDING VICTIM COMPENSATION STATUTE. >> COUNCILOR PRESSLEY YOU HAVE THE FLOOR. >> THANK YOU, MADAM PRESIDENT. LAST SATURDAY WE HELD OUR FIRST ANNUAL JUMP INTO PEACE EVENT IN MALCOLM X PARK IN ROXBURY. CELEBRATING GIRLS ORGANIZATION HE AND INCREDIBLE WORK PROMOTING HEALTH AND WELLNESS, SISTERHOOD, IT WAS A GLORIOUS DAY. THANK YOU, COUNCILOR CAMPBELL, COUNCILOR WU, NO ONE JUMPED THIS YEAR BUT WE THANK YOU FOR BEING THERE. WHEN I ORIGINALLY CONCEPTUALIZED THIS EVENT, IT WAS TO GO TO SPACES THAT HAD BEEN BESIEGED BY VIOLENCE AND TO TRANSFORM THEM INTO PLACES OF HEALING AND TO INFORM JOY, TO INFORM JOY. AND WE DID DO THAT. 200 PLUS PEOPLE CAME TO THE FOURTH ANNUAL EVENT. SADLY, DESPITE OUR BEST EFFORTS TO HOLD THAT SPACE AS A SPACE THAT WAS SAFE AND FILLED WITH JOY AND BUILDING PEACE AND COMMUNITY, THE NEXT DAY IT WAS MET BY GREAT VIOLENCE ONCE AGAIN. WE SAW SOME 15 SHOOTINGS, I THINK WITHIN A 36-HOUR OR TWO-DAY PERIOD. AND THAT SPACE IS NOT EXEMPT FROM THAT. I ALSO WANTED TO JUST THANK MAYOR. HE DIDN'T JUMP EITHER BUT I WANT TO THANK MAYOR FOR BEING THERE AS WELL, HE HAS ALWAYS SUPPORTED THE EVENT. I WANT TO THANK LUCY BROWN INSTITUTE, FIGHTING FOR DIGNITY FOR EVERYONE. THE PEACE INSTITUTE HAD REACHED OUT TO OUR OFFICE SPECIFICALLY WITH A STATE BILL AND I'M HONORED TO BE PART OF THEIR EFFORTS TO END CYCLES OF VIOLENCE AND AGAIN TO SUPPORT SURVIVING FAMILY MEMBERS WHO LOST LOVED ONES TO VIOLENCE TO GET ON A PATHWAY TO HEALING AND RECOVERY. FOR THOSE WHO DON'T KNOW THE VICTIM HEALING FUND, GOES TO RESTITUTION, AND SURVIVING FAMILY MEMBERS ARE THEN ABLE TO APPLY FOR FUNDS TO REIMBURSE THEIR LOVED ONCE FINAL CENSUS, HOWEVER BECAUSE OF A CLAUSE IN THE STATUTE, SURVIVING FAMILY CAN BE DENIED IF THE VICTIM CONTRIBUTED TO THEIR OWN DEATH. NOW, EVERY LOSS OF LIFE CAUSES A RIPPLE OF TRAUMA IN OUR

COMMUNITY AND THE INABILITY TO BURY A LOVED ONE PUNISHES A FAMILY FOR THEIR LOVED ONE'S MURDER, ENSURING EVERY FAMILY CAN SAY A FINAL GOOD-BYE OTHEIR LOVED ONE, HELPS BEGIN THE PROCESS OF HEALING AND IN TURN INTERRUPTS AND BREAKS CYCLES OF VIOLENCE. I'M VERY PLEASED TO BE PARTNERED WITH MY GOOD FRIEND AND CO-SPONSOR OF THIS RESOLUTION WHO HAS MADE GREAT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THIS BODY THIS HER ROLE AS CHAIR OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE, HOUSE BILL 742 ASK A MEMBER OF VICTIM COMPENSATION, THIS STATUTE IS SPONSORED BY STATE REP YVONNE I WOULD LIKE TO SUSPEND THE RULES AND ADOPT THE RESOLUTION. THANK YOU. >> THANK YOU COUNCILOR PRESSLEY. >> THANK YOU COUNCILOR PRESSLEY FOR YOUR PARTNERSHIP ON THIS. THIS IS AS COUNCILOR PRESSLEY SAID, THIS IS A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 742, THE VICTIM COMPENSATION STATUTE. IT'S TIMELY, GIVEN THE AMOUNT OF VIOLENCE WE'VE SEEN IN THE CITY RECENTLY. ALSO GIVEN THE FACT THE CITY OF BOSTON HAS STEPPED UP IN A MAJOR WAY. WE'VE ASKED THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 BE SET ASIDE IN THE BUDGETS FOR THIS VERY PURPOSE. THE MAYOR WAS ON BOARD AND ACTUALLY ABLE TO GET THAT DONE. THE STATE HAS NOT IN A LOT OF WAYS SAID SOMETHING. SO THIS IS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR US TO SIGN ON TO THIS RESOLUTION, TO SUPPORT THIS PARTICULAR BILL BUT TO REALLY SAY TO THE STATE WE CAN'T KEEP MAKING UP FOR IS FUNDING THAT KEEPS GETTING CUT FROM THE STATE. THIS IS A NEED THAT IS PREVALENCE AND NEEDED ACROSS THE ENTIRE CITY OF BOSTON, IT DOESN'T JUST APPLY TO DORCHESTER, MATTAPAN, EVERYBODY

WHO SURS FROM AN ACT OF VIOLENCE DESERVES RESOURCES TO HELP BURY THEIR LOVED ONE. IN THE LEGISLATURE THIS IS THE TIME FOR US TO STAND UP AROUND STAND UP TOGETHER AND TO MAKE OUR VOICES HEARD. LASTLY, I'LL SAY THE PEACE INSTITUTE HAS BEEN FOR DECADES PUSHING FOR THIS CHANGE, I APPLAUD REPRESENTATIVE CARVALLO FOR HIS WORK, BUT THE PEACE INSTITUTE DESERVES CREDIT FOR THE MOBILIZATION THEY HAVE CREATED OVER THE YEARS, NOT ONLY WHAT THEY DO IN TERMS OF THE PEACE WALK, BUT AT THE STATE LEVEL, FEDERAL LEVEL AND ACROSS THE COUNTRY TO REALLY GET FOLKS TO PAY ATTENTION TO THE TRAUMA THAT FOLKS IN THE COMMUNITY SUFFER EVERY SINGLE DAY WHEN THEY LOSE A LOVED ONE TO VIOLENCE. JUDGE COULD YOU PLEASE ADD COUNCILLOR ZAKIM'S NAME AND COUNCILLOR ZAKIM YOU HAVE THE FLOOR. >> THANK YOU, MADAM PRESIDENT. I'LL BE BRIEF. I WANT TO THANK THE CO-SPONSORS OF THIS IMPORTANT RESOLUTION AND JUST SAY I'VE HAD THE PLEASURE OF WORKING AND KNOWING TINA CHERRY AND THE LOUIS D. I'M GLAD THE REPRESENTATIVE HAS BROUGHT THIS FORWARD, THE LEGISLATURE WILL ACT FAVORABLY AND THE GOVERNOR WILL SIGN IT. THANK YOU AGAIN COUNCILOR CAMPBELL AND PRESSLEY, I'M PROUD TO ADD MY NAME. >> CAN YOU PLEASE ADD COUNCILOR ESSAIBI-GEORGE, COUNCILOR O'MALLEY, COUNCILOR BAKER, COUNCILOR JACKSON. THIS PAST LAST TUESDAY, I WAS AT THE HOME OF ACTUALLY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO TURNED OUT TO BE A DISTANT RELATIVE. IN THE CABE VERDEN COMMUNITY. A INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS SHOT AT 10:45 IN THE MORNING GETTING HIS HAIRCUT. THE NEXT DAY IN FRONT OF HIS GRANDMOTHER'S HOUSE WHILE PEOPLE WERE GRIEVING, A SHOOTER CAME UP AND SHOT SOMEONE IN FRONT OF

EVERYBODY. WE HAVE A CRISIS IN OUR CITY AND I DON'T THINK WE SHOULD COMPOUND THAT CRISIS OF DEALING WITH THE FINANCIAL BURDEN OF BURYING A LOVED ONE. IT IS SO CRITICAL AND THIS IS WHERE GOVERNMENT'S IMPORTANT. WE HAVE PEOPLE ATTACKING GOVERNMENT ALL OVER THE COUNTRY. THIS IS WHAT ACTUALLY GOVERNMENT IS SUPPOSED TO DO, TO STEP IN WHEN FOLKS ARE HURTING AND WHEN THEY NEED HELP AND THIS IS PATH TO DEALING WITH THE TRAUMA OF LOSING YOUR LOVED ONE. 75th ANNIVERSARY OF THE REPEAL OF THE CHINESE EXCLUSION ACT, TO MAKE SURE THESE CHINESE AMERICANS RECEIVE RECOGNITION FOR THEIR ACT. WHEN THEY WERE STILL FACING ABLATE ANT RACIAL DISCRIMINATION WITH THE CHOIRNZ EXCLUSION ACT. CHINESE EXCLUSION ACT. THE NUMBER BECAUSE OF THAT DETRIMENTARY LEGISLATION, OF THAT 120,000, 20,000 ACTUALLY STEPPED UP AND SERVED IN WORLD WAR II. OF THOSE 20,000 40% WERE NOT CITIZENS, THEY WERE PREVENTED FROM BECOMING CITIZENS UNTIL LEGISLATION DURING THE WAR. OUT OF THESE THEIR SERVICE WAS SPREAD ACROSS THE AIR FORCE AND OTHER BRANCHES. I DUD NOT KNOW A SIXTH OF THE CHINESE POPULATION SERVED IN THE WAR, A VERY, VERY BLOODY WAR IN OUR COUNTRY'S HISTORY, AND IT IS CRITICAL THAT WE ADMIT OUR WRONG AND THAT, IN OUR TIME, THAT WE STEP FORWARD TO GIVE HONOR TO THE MEN AND WOMEN WHO'VE STEPPED FORWARD SO WE CAN SIT HERE, BECAUSE NONE OF US SIT HERE WITHOUT THE HONORABLE SERVICE OF THESE CHINESE SOLDIERS BUT ALSO FOLKS WHO AREN'T EVEN CITIZENS WHO FOUGHT FOR OUR COUNTRY, WHO DIED FOR OUR COUNTRY AND WHO STOOD UP FOR US, I WANT TO THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR BRINGING THIS FORWARD. IT IS SO CRITICAL THAT WE ACKNOWLEDGE WHAT WE'VE DONE, AND WE FIX IT. PLEASE ADD MY NAME -- ACTUALLY, MY NAME IS ALREADY ADDED. >> THANK YOU, COUNCILLOR JACKSON. COUNCILLOR WU WOULD LIKE TO SUSPEND THE RULES AND ADOPT. AT THIS TIME WE'LL TAKE A VOTE ON DOCKET 1199. (VOTING) DOCKET 1199 WILL BE ADOPTED. >> DOCKET 1200, COUNCILLOR WU OFFERED THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE REGARDING THE RIGHT TO CHARGE. >> CHAIR RECOGNIZES COUNCILLOR WU. >> THANK YOU AGAIN, MR. VICE PRESIDENT. IN 2013, THE COMMONWEALTH OF

MASSACHUSETTS COMMITTED TO HAVING 200,000 ZERO EMISSION VEHICLES ON THE ROAD BY 2025. AS OF OCTOBER LAST YEAR WE ONLY HAD 2,000. I'M A LITTLE CONFLICTED STANDING UP HERE ADVOCATING FOR CARS BECAUSE YOU KNOW I HAVE MY BICYCLE AND PARKING SPOT IN THE GARAGE AND CONSTANTLY RAISING THE AWARENESS OF WE NEED OTHER MODES OF TRANSPORTATION. BUT FOLLOWING COUNCILLOR O'MALLEY'S IMPORTANT HEARING ORDER TODAY WE NEED TO DO EVERY SINGLE THING THE CITY CAN DO TO GET US TO THE POINT WHERE WE'RE ADAPTED AND READY FOR THESE EXTREME WEATHER EVENTS BUT TO DO OUR PART TO LESSEN THE CHANCE THEY'LL HAPPEN. THERE IS STILL TIME TO DO THAT. WE'RE SEEING DEVASTATING IMPACTS OF SUPERSTORMS, CLIMATE CHANGE. THE WESTERN PART OF THE UNITED STATES IS RAVAGED BY WILDFIRES BECAUSE OF HOW DRY IT'S BEEN BECAUSE OF TEMPERATURES. 30% OF GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS CONTRIBUTING TO CLIMATE CHANGE ACROSS THE UNITED STATES ARE FROM THE TRANSPORTATION SECTOR. 60% OF THOSE ARE FROM PASSENGER VEHICLES OR FUEL OR CARS. ELECTRIC VEHICLES ARE ONE WAY THAT WE CAN REDUCE THOSE EMISSIONS SIGNIFICANTLY. SECTOR VEHICLES PRODUCE LESS THAN HALF OF THE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS TRADITIONAL FUEL CARS DO AND THAT'S ACROSS THE AVERAGE OF ALL STATES INCLUDING MANY SOLAR-POWERED AND COAL POWERED STATES. THE CLEANER WE MAKE OUR UTILITY GRID, THE GREENER OUR ELECTRIC VEHICLES WILL BE AS WELL, THAT'S WHY OUR COMMUNITY CHOICE! ENERGY PUSH IS IMPORTANT. AGAIN, THIS IS A TECHNOLOGY THAT'S CHANGING QUICKLY. THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE MARKET HAS BEEN THOUGHT OF AS A VERY SORT OF LUXURY ITEM AND, YOU KNOW,

THEY'RE VERY, VERY EXPENSIVE, BUT AS SCIENTISTS AND BUSINESSES PROGRESS, WE'RE SEEING PRICES COME DOWN AND ACCORDING TO THE RECENT PROJECTION THE ELECTRIC VEHICLES ARE LIKELY TO BECOME COST COMPETITIVE IN THE NEXT COUPLE OF YEARS. HOWEVER, AS WE'RE ENCOURAGING RESIDENTS THINKING ABOUT GETTING RID OF THEIR FUEL-POWERED CAR AND MOVING TO AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE, WE NEED TO THINK ABOUT HOW THEY WILL CHARGE THE VEHICLE ACROSS THE CITY. WE CAN'T ENCOURAGE THE PEOPLE TO BUY THE CARS WITHOUT GIVING THEM A WAY TO DRIVE ACROSS THE CITY WHERE THERE IS NO WAY TO CHARGE. WE'RE STUCK IN THE CHICKEN AND EGG CYCLE WHERE THE CITY IS HESITANT TO INSTALL THE CHARGING STATIONS WITH NO DEMAND. ONE THING WE CAN DO AS A COUNCILLOR IS MAKE SURE THAT RESIDENTS WHO WANT TO CHARGE AT THEIR HOMES HAS THE RIGHT TO DO SO BOSTON HAS A LOT OF CONDOS, MANY MULTIFAMILY HOMES CONVERTED TO TWO-CONDO, THREE-CONDO BUILDINGS, AND THE CONDO LOCATION DOCUMENTS CAN OFTEN BE VERY STRICT. YOU NEED TO SIGN OFF EVERY SINGLE UNIT TO MAKE ANY SINGLE CHANGE IN THE PROPERTY. WHO WANTS THE TO INSTALL A CHARGING STATION FOR AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE AT THEIR HOME TO DO SO, DESPITE ANY CONDOS AND OTHER SIGNOFFS, AND THEN DO OUR PART IN TRYING TO MAKE THE INFRASTRUCTURE PIECE EASIER. FINALLY, YOU KNOW, AGAIN, WE ARE ALL FULLY COMMITTED TO VISION ZERO AND SAFE STREETS AND MAKING OTHER MODES OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ATTRACTIVE, AFFORDABLE AND COMFORTABLE. THIS IS ANOTHER STEP THAT WE NEED TO TAKE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO FIGHT CLIMATE CHANGE. SO THANK YOU EVERYONE WHO HAVE BEEN PART OF THIS ENTIRE PROCESS OF DISCUSSING AND PASSING THE ORDINANCE. >> THANK YOU, COUNCILLOR WU. IT SEEMS AS IF ALMOST EVERY MEETING WE ARE DEFENDING OUR CITY, OUR STATE AGAINST WHAT IS GOING ON IN WASHINGTON, D.C., AND THIS IS A BRUTAL ATTACK ON YOUNG PEOPLE AND YOUNG PEOPLE WHO FOLLOWED THE RULES, WHO STEPPED FORWARD AND DID WHAT THEY WERE ASKED TO DO, IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES IN THE

DACA PROGRAM. THIS PROGRAM AFFECTS 7934 YOUNG PEOPLE WHO LIVE IN MASSACHUSETTS AND ABOUT 6,300 OF THEM LIVE IN BOSTON. IT IS CRITICAL THAT WE SEND A MESSAGE THAT WE ARE STANDING UP FOR THE YOUNG PEOPLEPEOPLE IN THE BOSTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS. IT IS OVER 139 COUNTRIES AND NEARLY ONE IN TWO STUDENTS SPEAK THE LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH. I'M GRACIOUS FOR GOD'S COMFORT IN THE MIDST OF THE STORM. ALTHOUGH THE HOUSTON I CHERISH MOST IS SAFE, OTHERS IN

PORT ARTHUR, BEAUMONT, COASTAL SOUTHWEST LOUISIANA, PUERTO RICO, THE CARIBBEAN ISLANDS, THOMAS, ST. MARTIN AND MUCH OF THE ISLANDS IN COASTAL HAITI, THE SOUTHWEST FLORIDA KEYS ARE LESS FORTUNATE. MY PRAYER TODAY IS STRENGTH FOR ALL FAMILIES, FRIENDS AND LOVED ONES THAT HAVE BEEN AFFECTED BY AN OUTRAGEOUS AND IMPLAUSIBLE HURRICANE SEASON. ALTHOUGH HURRICANE HARVEY AND IRMA HAVE RAVAGED SO MANY SMALL CITIES, TOWNS, VILLAGES AND COMMUNITIES IN THEIR WAKE, I TRUST IN THE MAGNITUDE OF GOD TO PROVIDE. NO DOUBT, ANXIETY MANIFESTS IN AFFECTED AREAS, BUT GOD GRANTS UNSHAKEABLE PEACE TO RID THE STORM VICTIMS OF FEAR AND PLEASE SHOW US HOW TO RESPOND TO THE NEEDS OF THOSE STRUGGLING IN FRUSTRATION AND FEAR.
