The Boston City Council's Committee on Ways and Means will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, 20, 2018 at 1:00PM in the Iannella Chamber, 5th floor, Boston City Hall.

- 0405 <u>Message and order to reduce the FY18 appropriation for the Reserve for Collective</u> <u>Bargaining by Four Million Eight Hundred Twenty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty</u> <u>Eight Dollars (\$4,824,768.00) to provide funding for the Police Department for the FY18</u> <u>increases contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the City of Boston</u> <u>and the Boston Police Superior Officers Federation.</u>
- 0406 <u>Message and order approving a supplemental appropriation of Four Million Eight Hundred</u> <u>Twenty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Eight Dollars (\$4,824,768.00) to cover the</u> <u>FY18 cost items contained in the collective bargaining agreements between the City of</u> <u>Boston and the Boston Police Superior Officers Federation. The terms of the contracts are</u> <u>July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 and July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020. The major</u> <u>provisions of the contracts include base wage increases of 2% effective the first pay period</u> <u>of July of each fiscal year. The agreements also include increases to existing Quinn</u> <u>Bill/Education benefits, modified cumulative risk benefits beginning in July 2016 and</u> <u>increases to hazardous duty pay beginning in July 2017.</u>
- 0407 Message and order to reduce the FY18 appropriation for the Reserve for Collective Bargaining by Eighty Two Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Three Dollars (\$82,323.00) to provide funding for the Police Department for the FY18 increases contained within the collective bargaining agreements between the City of Boston and the Boston Police Detectives Benevolent Society-Forensic Group.
- 0408 <u>Message and order approving a supplemental appropriation of Eighty Two Thousand Three</u> <u>Hundred Twenty Three Dollars (\$82,323.00) to cover FY18 to cover cost items contained</u> <u>within the collective bargaining agreements between the City of Boston and the Boston</u> <u>Police Detectives Benevolent Society-Forensic Group. The terms of the contracts are October</u> <u>1, 2016 through September 30, 2017 and October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2020.</u> <u>The major provision of the contracts includes base wage increases of 2%, effective the first</u> <u>pay period of January of each fiscal year. The agreements also include other benefits</u> <u>including new specialty differentials beginning in 2018.</u>

These matters were sponsored by the Mayor, and referred to the Committee on March 14, 2018.
