HER PROUDEST ACCOMPLISHMENT IS BEING LUIS ALEXANDRIA AND ALEXANDER'S GRANDMOTHER, SO WE THANK HER FOR JOINING US TODAY AND WE ARE INSPIRED BY HER EFFORT EVERY DAY ON BEHALF OF VICTIMS OF VITAL CRIME AND OUR ENTIRE CITY AND WISH HER WELL IN HER ONGOING COLLABORATIVE WORK PARTICULARLY WITH RESPECT TO THE PEACE INSTITUTE AND HOPEFULLY A TIME WHEN WE CAN END VIOLENCE ON OUR STREETS IN ALL NEIGHBORHOOD IT.

YOU KNOW ULTIMATELY I THINK THAT WE ARE AFFIRMING HERE EACH WEEK WITH THESE ASSAULTS ON OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS THAT OUR DESTINIES ARE TIED.

WORKERS RIGHTS, WOMEN'S RIGHTS, THEY ARE ALL HUMAN RIGHTS. AND SO AGAIN I THANK YOU FOR YOUR LEADERSHIP.

INTO THAT.

I DON'T WANT TO NOTE FROM THE BEGINNING THAT THE CITY AND THE STATE MASCOT AND THE CITY OF BOSTON TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT HAVE MADE HUGE STRIDES IN OUR COMMITMENT TO GETTING TWO VISION ZERO AND THE MAYOR PUT A TON OF RESOURCES INTO PLANNING FOR DEDICATED BUS LANES AND PROTECTED CYCLE TRACKS. I WANT TO MAKE SURE THAT OUR ADVOCATE EXTENDS TO THIS VERY CONCRETE AND IMMEDIATE ISSUE OF LONGFELLOW BRIDGE AS WELL. SO LET ME GET A LITTLE BIT INTO THE DETAILS BECAUSE IT'S A VERY SPECIFIC ACT AND THAT'S THE FACT THAT, AT THE BRIDGE GOES FROM CAMBRIDGE INTO BOSTON IN BOUND IT'S STEEP ON THAT FIRST HALF OF THE BRIDGE.

AND WHEN IT'S THAT STEEP, WHEN YOU HAVE A NARROWER BIKE LANE IT ACTUALLY MAKES IT UNSAFE FOR CYCLISTS OF DIFFERENT ABILITIES WHO MAY NEED TO PASS EACH OTHER, CERTAIN SLOW PEOPLE ARE GOING UP THE INCLUDE AND OTHERS HAVE TO GO AROUND THEM INTO TRAFFIC. THE CURRENT PLAN THAT IS NOW APPROVED INCLUDES A PAINTED BIKE LANE WITH POSTS THAT WOULD STILL SQUEEZE CYCLISTS IN THAT HALF OF THE BRIDGE AND ENCOURAGE THEM TO GO AROUND.

WHAT THE COMMUNITY HAS BEEN CAN GO FOR FROM THE BEGINNING WHAT THE CAMBRIDGE CITY COUNCIL HAS UNANIMOUSLY SUPPORTED IS A VERSION WHERE THERE WOULD BE ONLY ONE IN BOUND CAR LANE COMING ACROSS THE BRIDGE FOR THAT FIRST HALF OF THE BRIDGE AND A WIDER CYCLING LANE PROTECTED ALL THE WAY SO THAT CYCLISTS CAN GET UP TO THE HUB OF THE BRIDGE.

AFTER THAT, IT WOULD GO BACK DOWN TO A NARROW BIKE LANE AND TWO LANES OF CAR TRAFFIC. MASCOT, WHERE.TO GIVE THEM FULL CREDIT, SINCE CAMBRIDGE PASSED THE RESOLUTION AND ON THE SAME DAY THAT THE BOARD HAD THEIR MEETING AND A LOT OF ADVOCATES SHOWED UP ON THAT SAME DAY THEY ANNOUNCED THEY WOULD TAKE IT ONE STEP FURTHER THAN THE INITIAL PLANS AND PUT IN THE SECTIONS AND TALK ABOUT A PILOT OF WHETHER WE CHANGE THE LANES FROM TWO TO ONE CAR LANES AND EXTEND THE CYCLE TRACK.
