## Boston Employment Commission Project Review

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### **BRJP Highlights and Concerns:**

- This project started November 2017, doing a few weeks of demolition work, before shutting down for the winter.
- BRJP addressed 0% Boston Residents and Female with Argus Construction on 1/19/18. On 1/22/18 Argus documented that work was done by current workforce and they have a Boston Resident and a woman joining the workforce when they start up again this spring.
- Concerns were again raised with Argus on 4/18/18 regarding Boston Resident and Female participation as a result of their April 2018 – June 2018 projection (see attachment date 4/18/18).
- See attached correspondence from Argus Construction regarding documented outreach efforts to Jobs Bank, Youth Build Boston, Madison Park Development Corp., Boston Career Link and Operation Exit.

Received 5/8/18 notice from Argus - they hired a Dorchester Resident. They also stated that no hires resulted from the resource list provided by OED/BRJP.

- Construction is now about 23% complete.
- Argus Construction (GC) performed over 90% of the total workhours reported, is exceeding the standards for people of color (37%), with only 6% Boston Residents and 0% Female.
- The overall average submission time for the weekly reports is 10 days.
- The 1 Boston Resident worker reported has been verified.

**RECOMMENDATIONS: OED / BRJP Office recommends that Argus Construction -**

**Submit current quarter (7/1/18 – 9/30/18) projections for the subcontractors expected to work onsite.**

**Coordinate with BRJP Monitor to schedule preconstruction meeting with subcontractors coming on site.**

**And subcontractors be proactive in their efforts to improve compliance, for the duration of construction and provide support documentation to address any deficiency.**

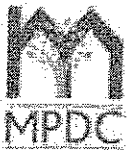

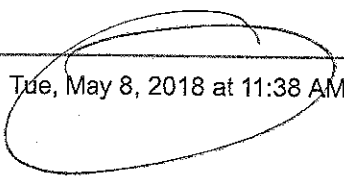
