I NOW TURN IT OVER TO DAN TO
DISCUSS THIS ORDINANCE IN
GREATER DETAIL.
SO DAN, YOU HAVE THE FLOOR.
WELCOME.
>> THANK YOU, COUNCILOR.
GLAD TO BE HERE.
SO WE'VE PUT THIS IN ORDER NANCE
FURTHER.
WE'VE BEEN THINKING ABOUT HOW TO
MAKE MOVING TRUCK PERMITS MUCH
MORE CUSTOMARY FRIENDLY, AND OUT
OF THAT PROCESS, WE REDID THE
ONLINE EXPERIENCE, AND WE ALSO
WENT FROM A TWO-STEP PROCESS .
WE HAD TO GO FROM PUBLIC WORKS
DEPARTMENT TO A ONE-STEP PROCESS
ON THE SECOND FLOOR.
OUT OF THAT PROCESS WORKING WITH
THE BT PUBLIC WORKS STAFF, THEY
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HIGHLIGHTED THE FACT THAT OFTEN RESIDENTS ASK FOR PERMITS FOR DELIVERY VEHICLES.

SO, USUALLY THAT MEANS LIKE A WASHING MACHINE, A COUCH, OTHER LARGE DELIVERIES THAT RIGHT NOW THERE'S NO PERMIT FOR THAT.
THERE'S A GENERAL PERMIT BUT YOU HAVE TO GET A BOND.

SO YOU HAVE A BE BONDED IN THE SYSTEM.

AND FOR A RESIDENT WHO'S GETTING A ONE-TIME DELIVERY, THAT'S A PRETTY HIGH MARK THAT WE'RE ASKING THEM TO GO FORWARD WITH. AND IT MAKES MORE SENSE FOR CONSTRUCTION COMPANY OR OTHER THINGS WHERE WE'RE WORRIED ABOUT THEIR DAMAGING THE STREET. SO FOR MOVING TRUCKS, WE TOOK I WAY THE NEED FOR A BOOND A A NUMBER OF YEARS AGO, AND WE WANT DO THE SAME THING WITH DELIVERY VEHICLES SO THAT A RESIDENT CAN GO ONLINE OR IN PERSON AND RESERVE SPACE ON THE CURB FOR A DELIVERY TRUCK.

>> ALL RIGHT.

SO SO THIS IS DIFFERENT FROM, SAY, LIKE LOCAL BUSINESS DISTRICT WHERE A POLAND SPRINGS TRUCK PULLS UP OR COCA-COLA OR PEPSI TRUCK OR FRITO-LAY TRUCK AND THEY'RE UNLOADING SODA AND CHIPS TO A CONVENIENCE STORE OR TO A LOCAL SUPERMARKET.

THIS IS IN THE NEIGHBORHOODS WHERE YOU MIGHT HAVE CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT BEING DELIVERED TO YOUR HOUSE OR AN HVAC OR SOMETHING MAYBE LIFTED ONTO YOUR ROOF.

IS THAT THE TYPE OF VEHICLE WE TALKING ABOUT?

>> SO I THINK IT COULD BE USED FOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES LIKE A POLAND SPRINGS TRUCK.

I THINK WE THINK IT WOULDN'T BE.
THOSE TYPE OF COMPANIES WERE
MAKING LOTS OF DELIVER WRIBS
YOU'D HAVE TO PUT UP SIGNS TWO
DAYS IN ADVANCE.

IT WOULD COST DESIGN DOLLARS PER DAY.

SO I THINK IT MORE MAKES SENSE IF YOU HAVE A VEHICLE MANY COULDING TO YOUR HOUSE IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND WILL SPEND 15 MINUTES TO A FEW HOURS THERE AND YOU WANT TO MAKE SURE THEY'RE NOT DOUBLE-PARKING AND CAUSING CONGESTION.

>> DOES IT INCLUDE UPS OR FEDERAL EXPRESS?

>> THEY COULD DO THAT BECAUSE THEY'RE DOING SO MANY SMALL DELIVERIES, I DON'T THINK THEY WOULD THINK IT WOULD BE WORTH IT BECAUSE THEY WOULD HAVE TO GO OUT AHEAD OF TIME AND PAY \$69 PER SPOT.

THEY COULD DO THAT NOW AND THEY HAVEN'T.

SO I THINK WE'RE SEEING THIS MORE AS HOMEOWNERS WHO HAVE A ONE OF HAD TIME NEED FOR THIS AS A COMPANY IS COMING TO DELIVER SOMETHING.

>> SO YOU ORDER A BEDROOM SET FROM A FURNITURE STORE.
THE TRUCK SHOWS UP AND THEY'RE GOING TO BRING THE BED, THE DRESSER --

>> EXACTLY.

THE -- THE LAMP, WHATEVER YOU AND EITHER ASSEMBLE IT OR DROP-AND-GO?

>> EXACTLY.

I'M ASSUMING DROP-AND-GO.

>> AND THEY'RE BEGAN BE ABLE TO PULL TO THE CURB OR DOUBLE-PARK OR --

>> THEY WOULD BE ABLE TO PULL TO THE CURB.

THEY'D BE ABLE TO RESERVE SPACE SIMILAR TO A MOVER TRUCK.

>> AND THE ONUS WOULD BE ON WHO TO PUT ON THE SIGN OR THE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT GOING TO RUN OUT AND DO THE SIGNS OR WHAT?

WOULD THE FURNITURE STORE HAVE TO COME OUT --

>> EXCUSE ME.

SORRY.

WHOEVER TOOK THE PERMIT OUT.

>> SO --

USUALLY THAT WOULD BE THE

HOMEOWNER SO THEY WOULD PUT IT OUT A COUPLE DAYS IN ADVANCE OR IF THE COMPANY WANTED TO DO IT, THEY ALSO COULD DO THAT, SIMILAR TO HOW -- LIKE GENTLE GIANT, THE MOVING TRUCK COMPANY WILL DO THAT NOW.

>> AND SO IF THERE WAS A -- I GUESS A SPECIFIC NEIGHBORHOOD OR A PORTION OF THE CITY WHERE THIS KIND OF PERCOLATED IS -- WAS THERE A HUMAN CRY FROM THE NEIGHBORHOOD OR CIVIC ASSOCIATION OR A RESIDENT IN ORDER TO DO THIS? >> THERE HASN'T BEEN ANY SPECIFIC RESIDENT OR NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION. I THINK JUST OVER TIME, ONCE A MONTH OR A COUPLE TIMES A MONTH, OUR STAFF GET A REQUEST FOR PEOPLE TO GET A PERMIT FOR A DELIVERY TRUCK AND THEY HAVE TO SAY, YOU KNOW, THE ONLY WAY YOU CAN GET A PERMIT FOR A MOVING TRUCK.

>> ONE OF MY CONCERNS IS WHEN YOU CALL DARN SOMETIMES THE DELIVERY COMPANY GIVES YOU A WINDOW AND THERE ARE TIMES WHEN THEY EITHER DON'T MEET THAT WINDOW SO I GUESS WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS ON MAKE THIS AS TIGHT AS POSSIBLE? YOU PARTICULARLY IN NEIGHBORHOODS WHERE PARKING IS AT A PREMIUM. THERE ARE NO SPOTS.

AND YOU COME HOME AND YOU SEE THREE, FOUR SPACES THAT HAVE THE SIGNS, "DON'T PARK HERE" ON TODAY, SEPTEMBER 24th, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF -- HOW WIDE ARE WE GIVING THESE DELIVERY COMPANIES? BECAUSE IT AIN'T ALL DAY, BECAUSE I'M NOT GOING TO SUPPORT AN ALL DAY.

IT HAS TO BE A LIMITED WINDOW AS TO -- YOU KNOW DEFINED START AND DEFINED FINISH AND IF THE DELIVERY ISN'T MADE BY A CERTAIN TIME, A CAR SHOULD BE ABLE TO PARK THERE.

IF THEY DOUBLE-PARK AND UNLOAD,

THEN THEY GOT DO WHAT THEY GOT TO DO.

IS IT A TWO-HOUR WINDOW, THREE-HOUR WINDOW?

BUT IT MOST DEFINITELY CAN'T BE

AN 8, 10, 12-HOUR WUNDO.

>> I THINK WE'D BEEN THINKING ABOUT IT SIMILAR TO MOVING TRUCKS WHERE IT'S A 7-TO-5 OR

I THINK WE DEFINITELY SHARE YOUR CONCERN AND CONSIDERED HAVING A SMALLER WINDOW.

>> PARTICULARLY WHERE THERE'S --IF THERE'S METERS, WE'RE MISSING OUT ON THAT REVENUE.

IT'S A \$50 FEE?

8-TO-6 WINDOW.

>> IT WOULD BE \$50 PLUS THE COST OF SIGNS AND ADMINISTRATIVE FEE SO IN ALL IT WOULD BE \$69 AND WE WOULD CHARGE FOR THE METERS SO IT WOULD BE \$69 PLUS THE METER FEE.

>> REALLY, I MEAN, THIS
ORDINANCE I'D HAVE TO -- I'D
LIKE TO HEAR FROM MY DISTRICT
COLLEAGUES PARTICULARLY THOSE
WHO ARE IN SORT OF DENSELY
POPULATED -- PARTICULARLY AROUND
THE DOWNTOWN, SORT OF BACK BAY,
BEACON HILL, SOUTH END, NORTH
END, SOUTH BOSTON WHERE, AGAIN,
STREETS ARE NARROW.

PARKING'S TIGHT.

I WOULD ARGUE THEY'RE NOT GOING TO GO FOR A 7:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M. WINDOW.

WE'RE GOING TO HAVE TO DO A
LITTLE BIT BETTER THAN THAT.
QUITE FRANKLY, I THINK THE
HOMEOWNER WOULD PROBABLY
APPRECIATE A LITTLE NUDGE ON OUR
END TO CLOSE THAT WINDOW THAT
THE DELIVERY COMPANY HAS TO
COME, BECAUSE WE'VE ALL
THERE.

YOU CALL":m¦Ñt
AND THEY GIVE YOU THAT FOUR OR
FIVE-POWER WINDOW AND -FIVE-HOUR WINDOW AND YOU SIT
AROUND ALL DAY LONG WAITING FOR
THEM AND THEY LITERALLY SHOW UP
15 MINUTES BEFORE THE WINDOW'S

AND HAD YOU KNOWN, YOU COULD HAVE GONE OUT, RAN SOME ERRANDS, THIS, THAT AND THE OTHER THING. IT BE A STICKER CREATED FOR THE
SIGN THAT SAYS, YOU KNOW, 24th OF SEPTEMBER FROM
WHATEVER TIME TO WHATEVER TIME?
THAT STICKER WILL BE CREATED AND

AND THAT WOULD BE MY ONE QUESTION.

MY SECOND QUESTION WOULD BE, AS FAR AS BTD ENFORCEMENT, I WOULDN'T -- I WOULD WANT TO MAKE SURE THAT IT WAS ON THE ENFORCEMENT UNIT'S DAILY SHEET AND MAYBE EVEN THE CAPTAIN OF THE DISTRICT'S MORNING SHEET JUST IN CASE, BECAUSE IF YOU'RE IN -- I'M JUST GOING TO SAY BACK BAY AND YOU'RE ON MARGBORO STREET, YOU'VE BLOCKED OFF FOUR SPACES AND YOUR TRUCK'S MANY COULDING TO BRING YOUR BRAND-NEW SOFA AND THEN SOMEBODY PARKS THERE , THEN YOU'VE PAID THE 69 BUCKS AND YOU'VE NOT HAD THE ENFORCEMENT.

>> YEAH.

THEY WOULD HAVE A STICKER SAYING

THE ADDRESS AND THE TIME OF THE RESERVE PARKING SPACES.

THEN THERE WILL BE TWO FACES AND THEN -- YEAH, ENFORCEMENT OF THAT IS REALLY IMPORTANT. >> RIGHT.

THAT IF SOMEBODY'S PARKING IN THEIR SPOT, WE GIVE YOU THE NUMBER FOR THE POLICE TOW LINE. WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO CALL EARLY SO THAT -- BECAUSE SOMETIMES IT TAKES A WHILE FOR THE POLICE TO MANY COULD OUT AND GO THROUGH THE PROCESS.

ALSO THE WAY IT WORKS NOW IS THE ONUS IS ON THE PERSON PULLING THE PERMIT TO HAVE TO ALSO FLYER THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND YOU SEE THE NOTICES THAT ARE AROUND THE CARS AND THE DOORS JUST SORT OF THERE'S NO UNSUSPECTING RESIDENTS OR MOTORISTS THAT MAY BE WORKING AT NIGHT AND COMES BACK THE NEXT DAY AND PARKS IN THAT SPOT.

NEXT THING YOU KNOW THEY'RE IN THE SPOT WHERE -- SO I DON'T KNOW IF THAT ONUS IS GOING TO BE THERE.

AND I GUESS IS -- WHAT IF SOMEONE IS -- WHAT IF SOMEONE --IF THIS ORDINANCE PASSES, WHAT HAPPENS IF SOMEONE GETS A DELIVERY AND THEY DON'T GET THE PERMIT?

>> FIRST, ON THE ONUS ON THE FLYER, IT WOULD BE THE SAME. WE WOULD ASK EMTHIS TO DOM TESTIMONY TWICE, ONE DAY BEFORE. >> SO I WOULD ASSUME THAT'S GOING TO BE MORE THE RES DENT. THAT'S NOT GOING TO BE THE JORDAN FURNITURE GUY COMING OVER 24 HOURS BEFORE LEAFLETTING -- >> RIGHT.

WHAT'S HIS NAME, ELLIOT --

ELLIOTT.

HE'LL BE RUNNING AROUND.
THAT AIN'T GOING TO HAPPEN,
RIGHT?

IT'S GOING TO BE THE RESIDENT THAT'S GOING TO DO THAT.
IN THAT INSTANCE, THE RESIDENT,
I'LL JUST TELL MY NEIGHBORS I

WHAT'S THE PUNISHMENT OR -- OR THE IMPLICATION IF YOU DON'T DO IT?

>> YES, THE INCENTIVE IS TO KNOW THAT YOU'RE GOING TO HAVE THAT SPACE ON THE CURB AND NOT TO HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT THE DOUBLE-PARKING ESPECIALLY IF THE DOUBLE-PARKING IS CAUSING PEOPLE NOT TO BE ABLE TO PASS.

I THINK JUST KNOWING YOU DON'T HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT IT

HAVE TO WORRY ABOUT IT.
>> AND THEN -- IN THAT INSTANCE,
THE ONLY PEOPLE THAT WOULD
REALLY BE WORRIED ABOUT THAT IS
IF WE WERE UNLOADING THE TRUGS.
BECAUSE IF YOU'RE NOT UNLOADING
THE TRUCK, WHAT DO YOU CARE,

SO IF I'M MOVING AND I'M GOING TO BE THERE WITH THE MOVING TRUCK AND MY BROTHER AND COUSINS AND EVERYONE'S PITCHING IN AND WE'RE GOING TO WANT THAT TRUCK TO BE RIGHT OUT IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE, IT JUST MAKES THE JOB EASIER.

BUT IF IT'S CONTRACTED OUT, IT'S KIND OF NOT REALLY ON YOU AND YOU KNOW THE TRUCK COMPANY'S NOT GOING TO PAY THESE THINGS AND LAY FLYERS.

RIGHT?

WOULD THEY TAKE ADVANTAGE OF IT?
IS IT TOO ONEROUS?

DO YOU HAVE ANY OTHER THOUGHTS AS WE'RE TALKING ABOUT IT?
WELL, THEN JUST THE BONDS -- THE

BOND PIECE OF IT. SO I UNDERSTAND IN THE MOVING SITUATION, A BOND IS REQUIRED?

NO LONGER. >> NO LONGER.

SO IN THIS PARTICULAR INSTANCE, THERE'D BE NO BOND REQUIRED.

ORDINANCE IS PEOPLE COULD
ALREADY GET A -- COULD ALREADY
RESERVE SPACE ON THE CURB IF

THEY WANT TO THROUGH A GENERAL

PARKING OCCUPANCY PERMIT.

THE BIG CHANGE IS VERY MOVING THE BOND JUST TO MAKE IT EASIER FOR A RESIDENT.

>> OKAY.

AND THEN SO WE'RE REALLY TALKING ABOUT SITUATIONS IN SORT OF THE HOMEOWNER SITUATION WHERE THEY'RE HAVING, SAY, A FURNITURE DELIVERY.

IF WE CAN GO DOWN TO THE LOCAL MAIN STREET, A LOCAL BUSINESS DISTRICT AND YOU GOT SORT OF A 7-ELEVEN OR A CORNER STORE AND THEY'RE GETTING A DELIVERY, HOW DOES THIS PLAY INTO SORT OF THE SMALL COMMERCIAL PIECE OF IT?

>> I THINK WE'RE NOT ENVISIONING THE SMALL COMMERCIAL BIGS USING IT BECAUSE IT'S NOT WORTH IT.

IT'S A FIVE-MINUTE, TEN-MINUTE DELIVERY HAPPENING EVERY DAY.

AND THEY COULD -- IF THE

WANTED I THINK WE WOULD HAVE HEARD A DEMAND ALREADY BUT WE HAVEN'T HEARD ANYTHING FROM THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY.

IT'S MORE WE'RE HEARING FROM RESIDENTS ASKING, HEY, I WANT TO RESERVE SPACE BECAUSE WE KNOW, YOU KNOW, THEY'RE GOING TO COME AND CHANGE MY WASHING MACHINE OUT.

THEY'RE GOING TO BE THERE FOR AN HOUR.

AND ON THE DONSTRUCTION SIDE -CONSTRUCTION SIDE, HAVING
CONSTRUCTION VEHICLES COMING AND
LIFTING DRYWALL OR STUFF ON THE
ROOF, HVAC UNITS AND STUFF WHERE
YOU HAVE A TRUCK AND A CRANE,

>> AND THEN DOES THE SIZE OF THE DELIVERY VEHICLE MATTER?
COULD IT BE A VAN VERSUS A
STRAIGHT JOB VERSUS A
TRACTOR-TRAILER?
>> I THINK WE HAVE UP TO TWO
SPACES SO I THINK A
TRACTOR-TRAILER WOULDN'T FIT IN
THAT.

SO I THINK IT'S BASED -- I DON'T KNOW EXACTLY LENGTH OF VEHICLE BUT IT WOULDN'T BE BEYOND TWO PARKING SPACES WHICH I THINK IS A RM NOEL A SIZE MOVING -- NORMAL SIZE MOVING TRUCK. >> OKAY.

ANY OTHER QUESTIONS ON THAT? I APPRECIATE YOUR TIME AND ATTENTION, DAN.

MY UNDERSTANDING IS THAT ACTION WOULD NEED TO BE TAKEN ON THIS MATTER BY WEDNESDAY, SO THAT'S EITHER THE COUNCIL CAN APPROVE IT OR THEY CAN REJECT IT OR REJECT IT WITHOUT PREJUDICE. WE'LL REACH OUT TO SOME FOLKS IN THE TRUCKING INDUSTRY IF YOU WILL TO KIND OF GET THEIR THOUGHTS ON WHETHER OR NOT THEY NEED IT.

AND AGAIN, I THINK 7:00 TO 5:00 MAY BE A LITTLE BIT ON THE LONG SIDE.

I'D LIKE TO TIGHTEN IT UP YET AND I DON'T KNOW WHAT THAT MAGIC NUMBER IS.

IS IT TWO HOURS OR FOUR HOURS OR DO WE HAVE A SLIDING SCALE?
>> YEAH, I THINK IT MAKES SENSE.
LET ME GET BACK TO YOU AND ->> OKAY.

I THINK THAT WOULD -- MAKES A LOT OF SENSE.

>> CHEW ON THAT.

IF TWO HOURS IS 25 BUCKS, FOUR HOURS IS 50 BUCKS AND YOU KNOW, WHATEVER, IF IT'S OVER THAT -- YOU CAN'T GET A GARAGE SPOT FOR
