Proposed Work: At rear of the structure 1stfloor. install 10'-0 wide glass door and 6'0 deep deck. Install penthouse setback from St. Botolph Street.

Proposed Work: At rear of the structure construct 1 story carport over
two existing parking spaces. Install roof deck on top of new carport.
Replace two existing windows to create a door and sidelights for roof
deck.

19.588 SB17 St. Durham Street #5Applicant: John Mucciarone; ZeroEnergy DesignProposed Work: At front, sides and rear facades of the structure, all
levels, remove non-historic aluminum windows and replace with one
over one aluminum clad windows.
