III. ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW/APPROVAL: In order to expedite the review process, the commission has delegated the approval of certain work items, such as those involving ordinary maintenance and repair, restoration or replacement, or which otherwise have a minimal impact on a building's appearance, to commission staff pending ratification at its monthly public hearing. Having been identified as meeting these eligibility criteria and all applicable guidelines, the following applications will be approved at this hearing:

▶ Applicants whose projects are listed under this heading NEED NOT APPEAR at the hearing. Following the hearing, you will be issued a Determination Sheet to present at the Inspectional Services Department (1010 Massachusetts Avenue) as proof of project approval when applying for permits. ISD personnel will send an electronic copy of your building-permit application to the commission staff for review. (To avoid potential confusion, the text of your building-permit application should be consistent with the project description given below.) Commission staff will accordingly authorize the execution of the work, attaching any applicable provisos, reflecting the relevant quidelines and precedents.

► PLEASE NOTE THAT FOLLOWING ISSUANCE OF THE DETERMINATION SHEET NO FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ISSUED FOR THE

APPLICATIONS LISTED BELOW. The electronic building-permit application as annotated by commission staff will constitute your Certificate of Appropriateness; this will be valid for one year from the date of the hearing. The applicant is required to notify the commission of any project changes; failure to do so may affect the status of the approval.

bay windows.

stairs, repair and repaint brownstone in kind, repair front lintels (all

levels in kind).

APP # 19.634 SE 660 Massachusetts Avenue At front façade level 4, replace 3, one

over one, wood windows with 3, two over two, wood windows.

APP # 19.646 SE **663 Tremont Street** At front façade, repoint, repaint steps **221 West Canton Street #3:** Proposed Work: At front facade garden APP # 19.639 SE and level 1, replace 5, two over two aluminum windows in kind. **45 West Newton Street** At front facade levels 4 and dormer level, **APP # 19.654 SE** restore windows, replace roof in kind, remove HVAC and satellite dish, replace trim in kind, install skylight. (See additional items in Design Review). **205 West Newton Street** At front façade dormer levels, replace APP # 19.658 SE existing vinyl windows with 2, two over two, wood windows and 2, one
