BOSTON, IT'S TIME TO LICENSE YOUR DOG!

If your dog is 6 months or older, you need to license them each year before **April 1**. A dog license is like an ID for your dog. If they ever get lost, the chances of you being reunited are much higher with a license.

APPLYING FOR A LICENSE:

When you apply for a dog license you must:

- give us a copy of your dog's current rabies certificate, and
- make sure you have paid any outstanding Animal Care and Control fines.

LICENSING FEES:

\$15 spayed/neutered (please provide proof) \$30 intact male/female

No charge for seniors 70 and older

For payments by mail or in person, we accept checks or money orders made payable to City of Boston Animal Care and Control.
