## **Event Description**


MBTA riders are invited to comment on a proposed fare increase that the Fiscal and Management Control Board is scheduled to consider in March after a month-long public comment period (see <a href="https://www.mbta.com/fare-proposal-2019">www.mbta.com/fare-proposal-2019</a> for details about public meetings). Under the draft proposal, fares would increase an average of 6.3 percent, with bus fares increasing by \$0.10, subway fares by \$0.15, a monthly LinkPass by \$5.50 and a weekly LinkPass by \$1.25. The proposed increases are below the 7 percent rate the MBTA is allowed to assess no more than once every two years. Revenues from the rate increase will help the MBTA to keep pace with inflation and support customer service enhancements that are part of the Authority's comprehensive \$8 billion modernization and improvement plan. If approved, the new fare schedule would take effect July 1, 2019.
