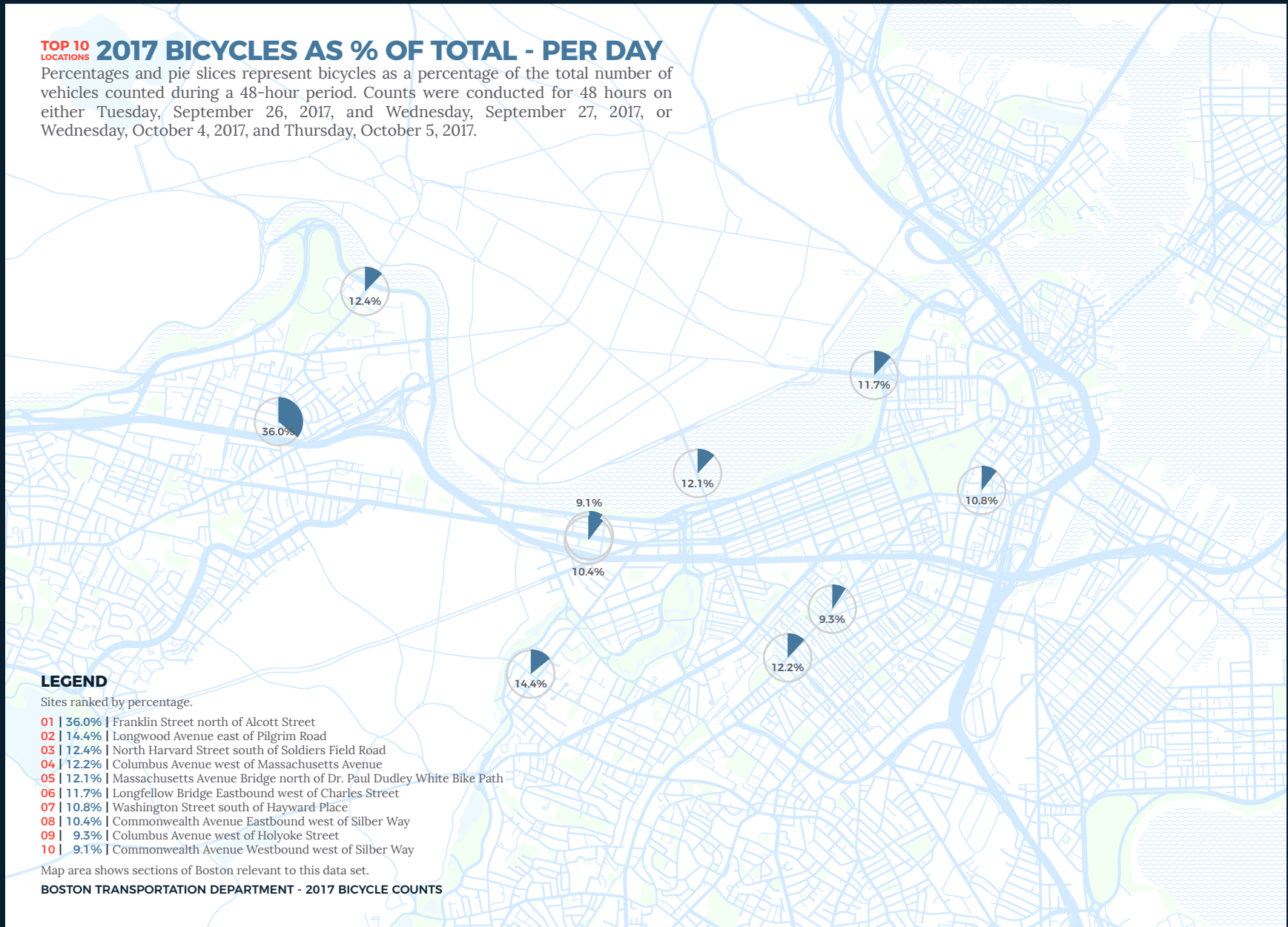


## TOP 10 LOCATIONS 2017 BICYCLES AS % OF TOTAL - PER DAY

Percentages and pie slices represent bicycles as a percentage of the total number of vehicles counted during a 48-hour period. Counts were conducted for 48 hours on either Tuesday, September 26, 2017, and Wednesday, September 27, 2017, or Wednesday, October 4, 2017, and Thursday, October 5, 2017.



### LEGEND

Sites ranked by percentage.

- 01 | 36.0% | Franklin Street north of Alcott Street
- 02 | 14.4% | Longwood Avenue east of Pilgrim Road
- 03 | 12.4% | North Harvard Street south of Soldiers Field Road
- 04 | 12.2% | Columbus Avenue west of Massachusetts Avenue
- 05 | 12.1% | Massachusetts Avenue Bridge north of Dr. Paul Dudley White Bike Path
- 06 | 11.7% | Longfellow Bridge Eastbound west of Charles Street
- 07 | 10.8% | Washington Street south of Hayward Place
- 08 | 10.4% | Commonwealth Avenue Eastbound west of Silber Way
- 09 | 9.3% | Columbus Avenue west of Holyoke Street
- 10 | 9.1% | Commonwealth Avenue Westbound west of Silber Way
