NEW POLLING LOCATION: **HILL HOUSE COMMUNITY CENTER – 127 MOUNT VERNON STREET. VOTE IN COMMUNITY ROOM (INSIDE FIRE DOORS).**

OLD POLLING LOCATION: CHURCH OF THE ADVENT – VOTER ENTRANCE 145 MOUNT VERNON STREET. VOTE IN LIBRARY. HP ENTRANCE THROUGH 30 BRIMMER STREET.

WARD 5 PRECINCTS 7 AND 8

NEW POLLING LOCATION: **COPLEY SQUARE LIBRARY, 700 BOYLSTON STREET. VOTER ENTRANCE DARTMOUTH STREET. VOTE IN GUASTAVINO ROOM OF THE MCKIM BUILDING**
